AN EVENING OF CONVERSATION

Mr. Jefferson Hosts Dolley Madison, the “first First Lady”

As a widower, President Thomas Jefferson often called on Dolley Madison to serve as the unofficial first lady for White House functions. The ceremonial and political functions she hosted were a pragmatically significant part of conducting business in the new capital.

Join the conversation on May 3, 2008 to mark the 200th anniversary of Jefferson’s final year as President of the United States. Mrs. Madison and Mr. Jefferson will converse on topics from the political demands of the presidency, to Washington City society, to the “great little Madison.” As always, the audience is invited to participate!

Dolley Madison, with her husband James, was a constant fixture in Jefferson’s life as President. Her social graces made her famous but her political acumen is less renowned. She knew every President personally, from George Washington to Zachary Taylor. Upon her death at age 81, Taylor eulogized her as the “first lady of the land for half a century.”

She will share her thoughts on her husband’s long friendship with Jefferson and her own successful fundraising endeavors, including bringing together Washington society to support the Lewis and Clark expedition.

Thomas Jefferson will again be played by Bill Barker, Colonial Williamsburg’s renowned Jefferson interpreter. Dolley Madison is portrayed by Lauren Leigh, a Ph.D. candidate at the University of North Carolina at Greensboro. Ms. Leigh has

Support from Friends this year can peel back the soil to uncover new parts of the artifact-rich archaeological site in a heavily-used part of Jefferson’s 61-acre curtilage. We aspire to identify there new clues about how Jefferson organized and shaped both the aesthetics and functions in his villa landscape— as well as insight into the lives of the people of Poplar Forest’s plantation community.

Land rescue of unprotected parts of the retreat remains a priority, as we strive to bring back all of Jefferson’s 61-acre curtilage. And ahead, beyond spring 2009, lies a new horizon— the exciting prospect of beginning the first phase of landscape restoration, encompassing both archaeology and the first replanting of long-missing trees and ornamental gardens.

WING OF OFFICES

NEARS 2009 MILESTONE

In 2009, Jefferson’s “wing of offices” will be unveiled and visitors to Poplar Forest will, for the first time in over 160 years, see the exterior of the house as he designed it.

Visitors to the wing in 2008 will see windows and doors in place and witness the installation of the final layer of Jefferson’s “terras” roof.

Jefferson’s unusual roof design to create a flat “terras” deck over the wing provided the means to a mode of outdoor living that would seem very American by the end of the twentieth century.

This winter, staff has begun to add a few finishing touches to the wing, crafting doors and window frames and installing window sashes. In 2008, the flat layer of decking will be laid.

Jefferson’s wing at Poplar Forest represents a personal blend of ancient and modern architectural features. From the 16th-century Italian villas of Andrea Palladio, Jefferson learned the convenience of attaching flanking service rooms to the main house.

POPLAR FOREST INCLUDED ON WORLD HERITAGE NOMINATION LIST

Recognition Signifies Global Importance of Jefferson's Retreat

Poplar Forest has been included as one of fourteen sites on the U.S. Department of Interior's Tentative List, from which it will draw its nominations to the World Heritage List over the next ten years. The UNESCO World Heritage List recognizes the most significant cultural and natural treasures on the planet.

Poplar Forest has been proposed together with the Virginia State Capitol to be added to the Jefferson-themed listing already on the World Heritage List, which includes Monticello and the University of Virginia.

The World Heritage List is an exclusive listing of the world's most important cultural and natural sites, such as Stonehenge, Machu Picchu, the Acropolis, and the Taj Mahal.

In October 2007, Dr. Joseph Wang, Professor of Architecture at Virginia Tech introduced Poplar Forest to an architectural conference in Beijing, China in a paper titled, "Preservation and Restoration: A Lesson from the West."

Architectural historians and preservationists from China and around the world gathered to commemorate the 300th anniversary of the construction of Yuanming Yuan. Completely destroyed in 1860, Yuanming Yuan (literally meaning "Round and Brilliant Garden") served as the headquarters of five Qing monarchs and

was intended to combine pleasurable living, garden arts and official governmental functions.

Dr. Wang presented the ongoing work at Poplar Forest to demonstrate to Chinese colleagues how Americans have approached historic preservation and restoration.

AT THE “MYSTERY SITE,” A POSSIBLE EXPLANATION

This large trench has revealed a considerable quantity of Jefferson-era ceramics and other domestic debris.

Through the winter's lab analysis, archaeologists have continued to find more and more connections between the artifact-rich site known as Site B, and Jefferson's ornamental plantings at Poplar Forest. The exciting finds indicate the increasing possibility that Site B may have been the location of Jefferson's ornamental plant nursery – where trash and animal manures came together before being distributed across the landscape as fertilizer or in the root balls of young plants.

The nursery hypothesis stems from several remarkable instances of direct links between what has been found at Site B with what was found in the planting holes for ornamental plantings both near the house and along the sunken lawn.

Of greatest interest are crossmends of ceramic fragments between Site B, a layer of soil associated with shrubs planted along the east bank of the south lawn, and deposits northwest and southwest of the house where Jefferson planted ornamental tree clumps.

Archaeologists found that the fragments of the same ceramic bowl from Site B mended with fragments found in the soil of what had been a planting hole in a bed next to the house. Several more of these crossmends were then identified, linking the possible nursery to other ornamental planting holes, including ones along the sunken lawn.

Evidence within the soil itself will also test this hypothesis. With snow flurries swirling in early January, the archaeology department collaborated with the Archaeology Research Laboratory at the University of Tennessee Knoxville to take specialized soil samples from the Site B gully. The Lab's analysis will detect chemical signatures in the soil that can reveal the presence of animal manures, hearth waste, and other materials commonly found in nursery soils.

At the same time, pollen analysis on the same samples will be conducted by the Fiske Center for Archaeological Research at the University of Massachusetts Boston for comparison with pollen samples taken from the south lawn.

These steps will set the stage for beginning landscape restoration—for which private-sector support will be needed to accomplish archaeological excavation and restoration of Jefferson's plantings.



Congressman Bob Goodlatte has announced a \$195,000 appropriation to support opening a new dimension of Jefferson’s retreat—enabling the public to begin exploring Jefferson’s landscape vision in 2009. The first step is to reconstruct the curtilage fence, allowing visitors to personally and physically experience the size and scope of Jefferson’s retreat environment.

Once the structural demarcation of Jefferson’s ornamental landscape is restored, the next step will be to equip visitors with electronic handheld devices to walk the curtilage.

“Congressman Goodlatte’s leadership will make it possible for visitors to Poplar Forest to learn more about what archaeology and historic documents have revealed and what we continue to discover about Jefferson’s most personal landscape,” said George Ramsey, Board Chairman.

OCTAGONAL PLATES

GIVEN TO POPLAR FOREST

Provide clues to fragments found at Jefferson's Retreat

Poplar Forest has recently received three antique plates from the Oxford and Cambridge College Series of ceramics from Kathy and Pete Hendricks of Atlanta, Ga.

This series of ceramics, produced in England between 1814 and 1830, depicts images of architectural and educational edifices in the two cities. Printed on plates, saucers, and platters, the central image is always bordered with an octagonal frame surrounded by floral scrollwork.

Archaeologists have recovered numerous fragments of the Oxford and Cambridge series from the Wing of Offices, the current archaeological site, and the South Lawn. From this, we know that vessels from this same collection were used at Poplar Forest.

The fragments found at Poplar Forest depict scenes of Radcliffe Library (Oxford), Christ Church (Oxford), Theatre Printing House

The presence of plates from this ceramic series continues the octagonal theme of Poplar Forest.

(Oxford), Wadham College (Oxford), and Sidney Sussex College (Cambridge).

The generous gift to Poplar Forest includes two small plates (190mm in diameter) and one larger plate (250mm in diameter). The donated plates will be used by archaeologists to make comparisons with fragments found at Jefferson's retreat.
